Step 1: \$1,000 in an emergency fund
((\$500 if your income is under \$20,000 per year)

Step 2: Pay off all debt except the house utilizing the debt snowball (found in the Dumping Debt lesson)

Step 3: Three to six months expenses in savings

Step 4: Invest 15% of your household income into Roth IRAs and pre-tax retirement plans

Step 5: College funding

Step 6: Pay off your home early

Step 7: Build wealth and give!
